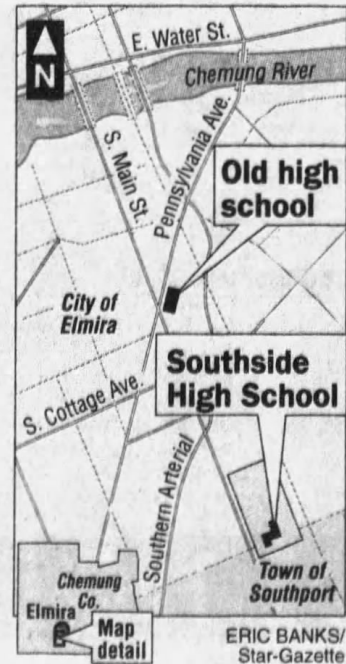
Some students at Southside High School said Wednesday that they do not think their classmates are developing cancer because of contamination on the school grounds.
