

# Cancer: District hires legal help for probe

the technical information developed to date. She said the lawyers will help the committee get more information to the board in order to help it "make the right decision for the community."

"Basically, nobody on the board at the present time is knowledgeable about environmental issues and the procedures that we need to follow correctly as far as the Southside issue is concerned," acting board president Walter M. Badeau said Friday. "And we wanted to make absolutely sure that the decisions we make are correct."

In mid-June, the city of Elmira offered similar reasons when it hired environmental attorney Slater to monitor and advise the city on possible environmental contamination around Southside High School. The city has authorized up to \$15,000 to pay Slater, who works for the law firm of Harter, Secrest & Emery, also in Buffalo.

Sherwood said she couldn't say how much the two lawyers will cost the district because she does not know how long the district will need their services. She did

say, however, that the district sets aside emergency money in the budget each year to pay unforeseen expenses.

Sherwood added that the district will continue to cooperate with the

county and state departments of health as the Southside investigation continues.

Phone calls to Kennedy and Meosky's office in Buffalo were not returned Friday afternoon.
